- Tell me about where you grew up.

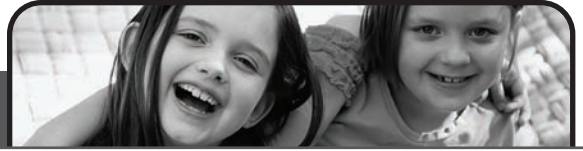
- What stories does your family tell about when you were very little?
